Cookery Categories – 50 pence per entry

- 1 lb (454 gm) Jar of Strawberry Jam – your favourite recipe!
- 7" Chocolate Victoria Sandwich Cake – recipe provided overleaf
- 4 Fruit Scones – recipe provided overleaf
- 6 Shortbread Biscuits – recipe provided overleaf

The **Crumbs Plate** will be awarded to the entry judged to be the overall winner in the Cookery Category.

Craft Categories – 50 pence per entry

- A. Any 'Christmas-themed' patch-work item
- B. Any hand-crafted toy made of wool, felt, material etc

Recipes

7" Chocolate Victoria Sandwich Cake:

5 oz SR flour 1 oz cocoa powder 6 oz caster sugar
6 oz marg 3 eggs a little milk if necessary

Use creaming or all-in-one method. If using all-in-one method add 1 teaspoon of baking powder. Bake 200C/400F/GM5 for about 15 minutes or until risen and firm to touch. When cold, sandwich together with vanilla buttercream. Do NOT dredge with sugar.

4 Fruit Scones:

8 oz SR flour 1 tsp baking powder 2 oz margarine
2 oz caster sugar 2 oz sultanas 1 egg (beaten)

Add baking powder to flour. Rub in marg. Add sugar and sultanas and mix together with the egg. (Use a little milk if necessary.) Knead lightly on a floured surface. Roll out to ¾" thick and cut into rounds using a 2" fluted cutter. Brush tops with milk and bake at 200C/400F/GM5 for about 12 minutes or until risen and golden.

6 Shortbread Biscuits:

8 oz butter 4 oz caster sugar 10 oz plain flour

Rub butter into flour and add sugar. Knead together. Roll out to ¼" thick and cut into rounds with a 2" plain cutter. Bake at 120C/250F/GM ½ for about 40 minutes or until just golden. Carefully remove to cooling rack.

1lb Jar Strawberry Jam:

It could be Great Aunt Gertie's old family recipe that's been handed down through the ages or it could be a recipe you just clipped out of Woman's Own last week...woo us with 1lb of your favourite home-made strawberry jam!!!!

NOTE: All BAKED items are to be made within 24 hours of presentation.
