YOUNG HANDLERS

These classes are kindly sponsored by Easton College, Norwich, Norfolk

Judging to take place at approximately 2.30pm, immediately after the Group of Three.

NO ENTRY FEE - Entries will be accepted on the day.

Classes to be judged solely on the handler's ability, not on the animal. Handlers to lead animals that have been exhibited in breed classes. PLEASE NOTE: SAFETY IS VERY IMPORTANT. In CLASS 40 (Junior Young Handler) children must be able to control the sheep or must be supervised by a responsible adult.

CLASS 56: Junior Young Handler

aged 6 years and under on day of show
