All young handlers under 17 years of age who have shown Shetland in the above classes to return to the ring for the presentation. All young handlers under 14 must wear hard hats. Children under 14 may not show Colts (*excluding foals*) or entire males.

- **SPSBS Best Miniatuure Rosette & The Redferns' Tankard**

TooHoots Stud Perpetual Trophy for reserve Best Minature.

Highest placed Minatures from all 4 Classes to return to the ring

For the Judge's final decision and presentation.

## Rules – Please read carefully

1. Classes 501 to 504 are confined to Shetland ponies registered with the SPSBS 3 year old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. Foals 3 weeks old minimum.
2. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry & to substitute a judge without prior warning & to cancel any class refunding class fees paid.
3. The Judges decision is final.
4. No substitution or nomination entry will be accepted.
5. A Judge may not place a pony ,which to his/her knowledge has been bred, sold, leased or produced by the Judge or his/her immediate family or employer; nor a pony in which he/she has a financial interest or an entire he/she has had a mare stunted by in that season. Should this situation arise the Show Secretary should appoint a referee to place that pony.
6. Animals that behave in an uncontrolled or dangerous manner in the opinion of the judge or steward will be asked to leave the ring or show.
7. All colts or entires 2 years & over must be shown bitted.
8. Rosettes to 7<sup>th</sup> ,no prize money. Name & address & signature must be given for each Trophy.
9. Exhibitors must ensure all entries are covered by Public Liability Insurance and entry in this event deems acceptance of these rules.
