



Electronic pig movement licensing 'eAML2' for show grounds

1. In summary

The exhibitor sets up the on and off move(s) to show(s) her/himself.

The show ground does not need to issue any movement licences but must retain the 'on' movement document (under eAML2 called 'Haulier Summary') at the show ground for the show herd register.

Section 'D' on this form needs to be completed.

Each movement is a separate movement to be entered on to the eAML2 system and haulier summary sheets printed out.

The eAML2 system allows the whole sequence of movements to be entered on to the system at once. The exhibitor confirms the movements either by text/online or through the eAML2 Bureau; outstanding feedback will be escalated through a chase procedure.

2. Step by Step Process:

Exhibitor with I.T – completing move online

- To go online to www.eaml2.org.uk & to set up on & off move(s)
- To print out the 1 page haulier summary **per movement** with an individual reference number (automatically created by the eAML2 system)
- To load up pigs & confirm load i.e. actual number of pigs loaded, vehicle registration & dead on arrival by text message or online when back home within 3 days

At show

- Upon arrival, exhibitor must hand over the 'on' movement haulier summary sheet for retention by the show to meet their herd register requirements. No need for show organiser to send a copy to trading standards as exhibitor will confirm movement either by text message or online back home. The movement information is then automatically uploaded to the Government database and the relevant Local Authority receives an automatic notification from eAML2 detailing the movement.

Off move from show ground

- Exhibitor will have a haulier summary already printed and with him/her. On the day of dispatch: annotate any changes
- Exhibitor to confirm numbers arrived & any dead on arrivals & sale of pigs online when back home or by text within 3 days

3. Exhibitors without computer/internet/email

There is the free to use eAML2 Bureau Service which will set up movements on the exhibitor's behalf if they have no access to a computer with internet

The exhibitor can contact the Bureau Service by phone/fax/post to have any show movements entered on the eAML2 system. The Bureau Service will return the appropriate number of Haulier Summary sheets to the exhibitor to take to the show and back. Exhibitors without IT need to keep a copy of their Haulier Summary sheet for their records.

Movements will also be confirmed by contacting the Bureau Service.

4. Sale of pigs at a show

Exhibitor - Seller

- to take blank haulier summaries (available online/Bureau Service) in case pigs are sold off during show
- to record details of new owner (name/address/phone/CPH & herd mark if known) to enter online when back home
- to copy individual movement reference from his/her 'on' movement onto blank haulier summary sheet for buyer
- to confirm number of pigs sold at show as part of movement feedback within 72 hours and to enter details of new owner

New owner - Buyer

- to complete blank haulier summary given by seller with address details for move home
- after arrival home to go to www.eaml2.org.uk to report movement retrospectively quoting the movement reference from haulier summary within 72 hours of movement

If Buyer does not have a registered premise i.e. no CPH/Defra herd mark

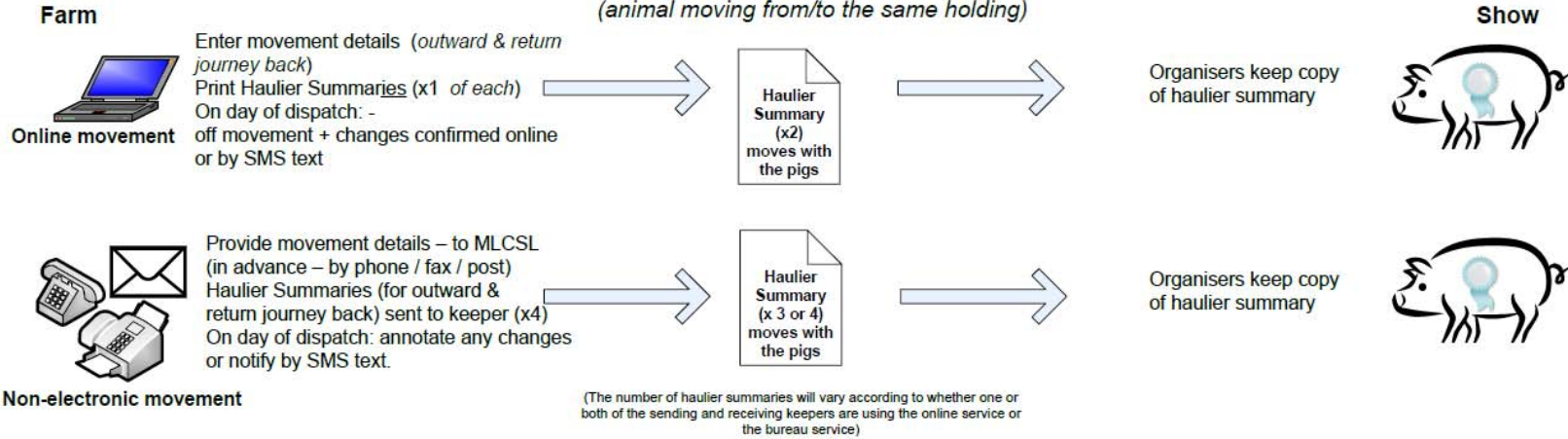
- Buyer must register premise with local Animal Health office
- Register on eAML2
- Complete movement feedback either online or via Bureau Service

5. Exhibitors moving pigs on a carbon paper AML2 form past 1 April

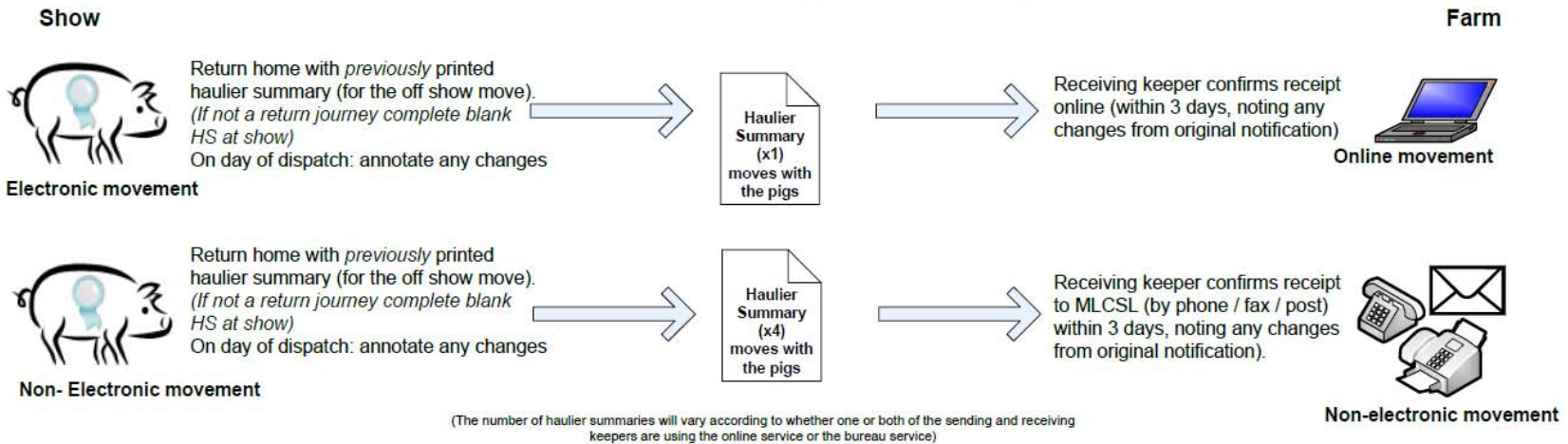
We will disseminate leaflets to show grounds with instructions for exhibitors. When mailing the passes to exhibitors show grounds can then include a leaflet as a reminder.

If an exhibitor still turns up using an old style carbon paper AML2 form she/he needs to contact the eAML2 Bureau Service.

Example of a farm to show move
(animal moving from/to the same holding)



(For return moves to/from a show the haulier summaries for both moves will need to be printed when the move is first notified to MLCSL, or the sending keeper if he/she is notifying the move electronically)



(For non electronic moves using the bureau service haulier summary changes can also be sent by SMS text)
